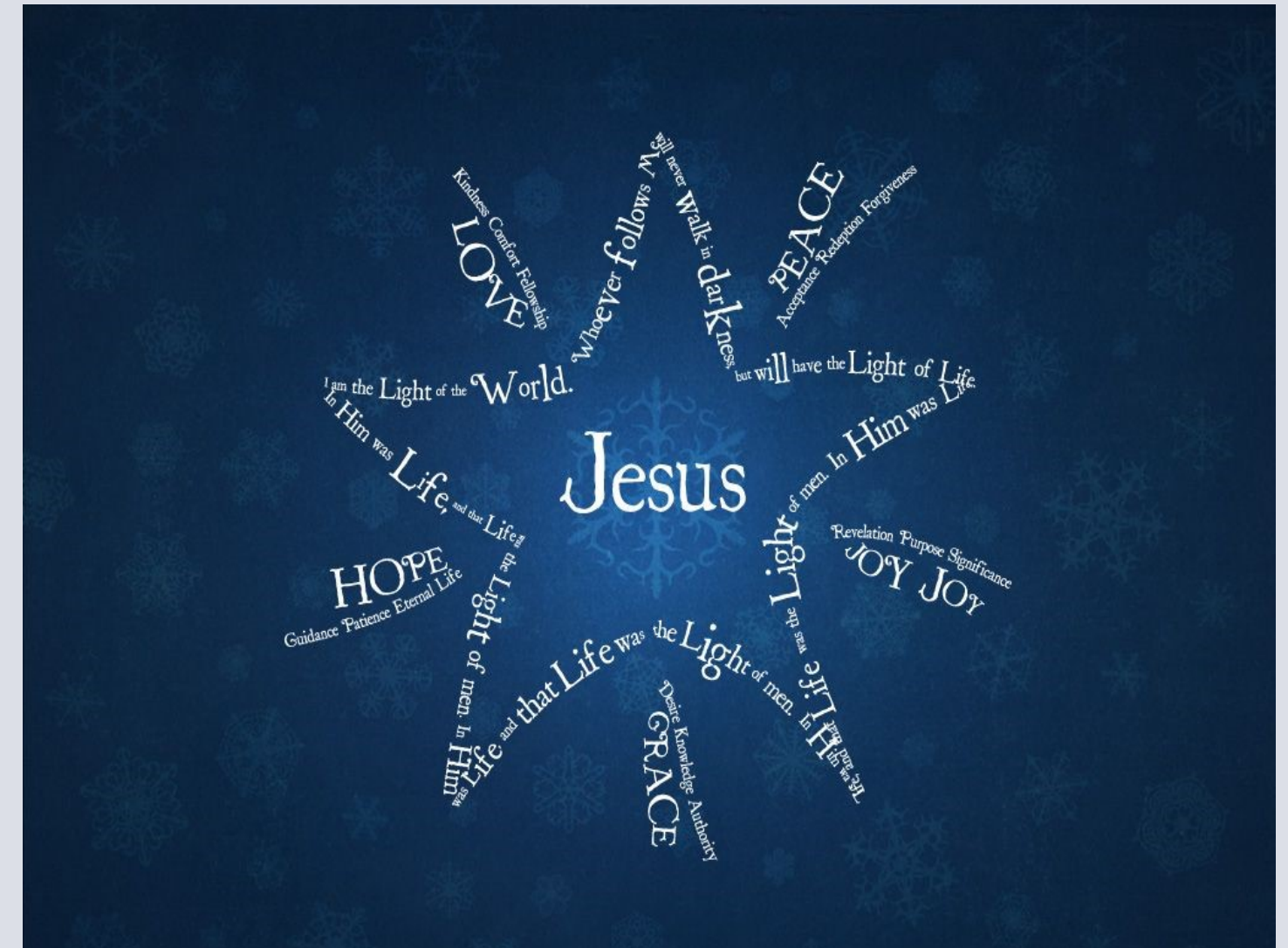
St. James has Sunday School from 9:50 a.m. to 10:50 a.m. via Zoom. Come, join us!
